

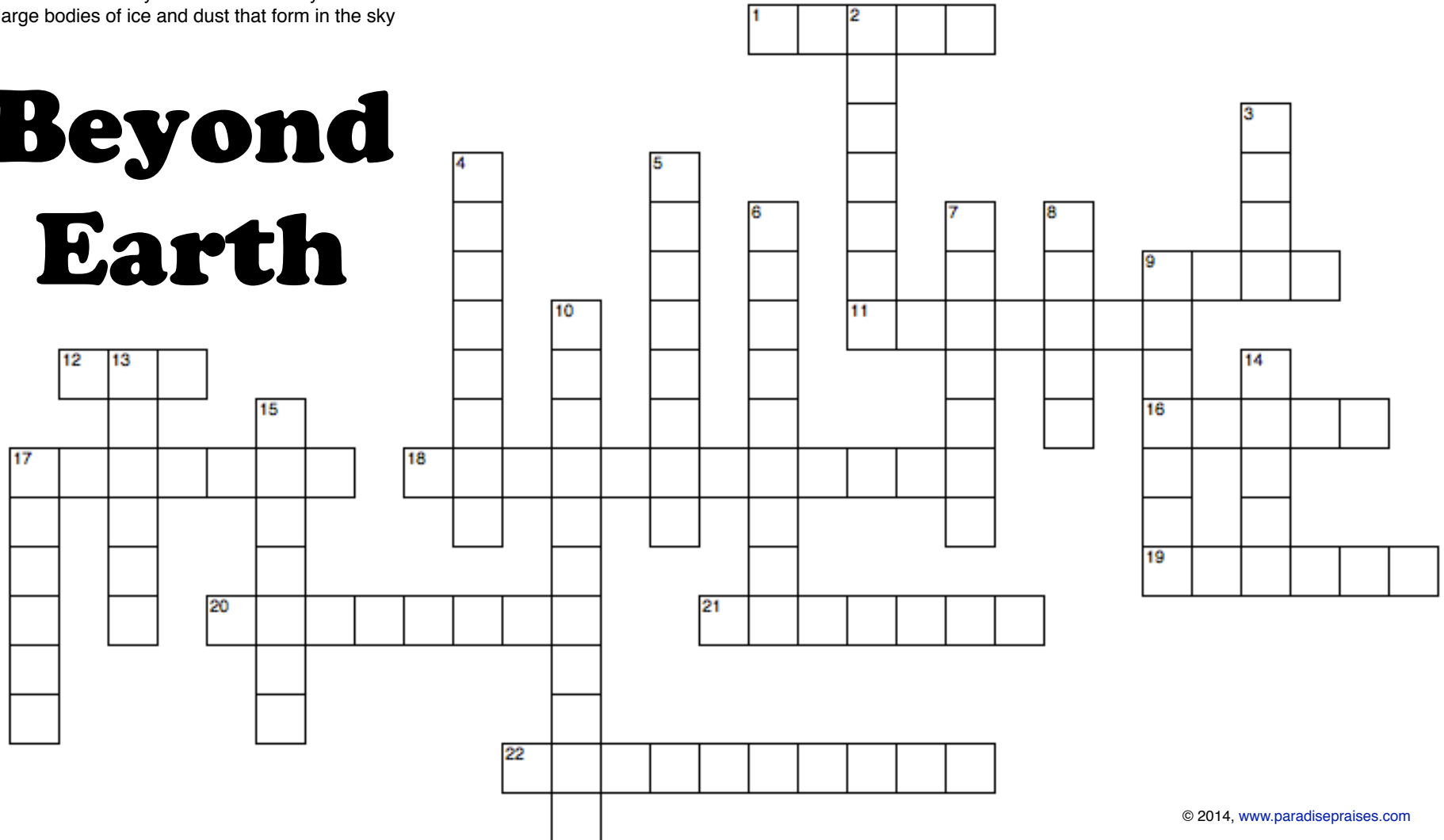
DOWN:

2. phase in which the Moon appears totally black

4. phase in which the entire side of the Moon is sunlit and visible as a complete circle
